

## **AOC Clinical Safety Notice - 08/09/2022**

## Acute Behavioural Disturbance (ABD) is a time-critical emergency.

Symptoms overlap with other disease presentations and can include

acute psychosis, extreme aggression, hyperthermia, rapid breathing, and excessive strength

Early management of hyperthermia, hypovolaemia, and agitation is essential;

patients must be restrained for as little time as possible.

The patient **must** be continually monitored as deterioration happens rapidly.

If a patient is actively restrained by the police, or the police state that the patient has ABD,

this **must** generate a C1 response. Also ensure CCD are aware.
