

## **Ops Staff Safety Notice -** 08/09/2022

## Acute Behavioural Disturbance (ABD) is a time-critical emergency.

Symptoms overlap with other disease presentations and can include

acute psychosis, extreme aggression, hyperthermia, rapid breathing, and excessive strength

Early management of hyperthermia, hypovolaemia, and agitation is essential;

patients must be restrained for as little time as possible to reduce the risk of positional asphyxia.

The patient **must** be continually monitored as deterioration happens rapidly.
