Luke collapsed while enjoying a day at the dogs in 2017. He survived his cardiac arrest thanks to bystander CPR, the swift response from EEAST and the care received from NNUH. Since his arrest Luke has been determined to improve other people's chance of survival by funding advanced resuscitation training to those who arguably make the biggest difference.
