

In response to identifying the training which Face Fit testers had previously received, EEAST procured 'Safer UK' to deliver qualitative training.

Safer UK are one of only 17 approved fit 2 fit Face Fit training providers and provided training for 48 EEAST Staff, inclusive of Education & Training Officers. Additional trainers were also identified and additionally trained, in local areas.

Since March, staff have received Face Fit testing which complies with best practice for fit testing, to improve staff safety whilst wearing PPE.

The Trust plans to nominate Face Fit testers to become fit 2 fit accredited trainers.
