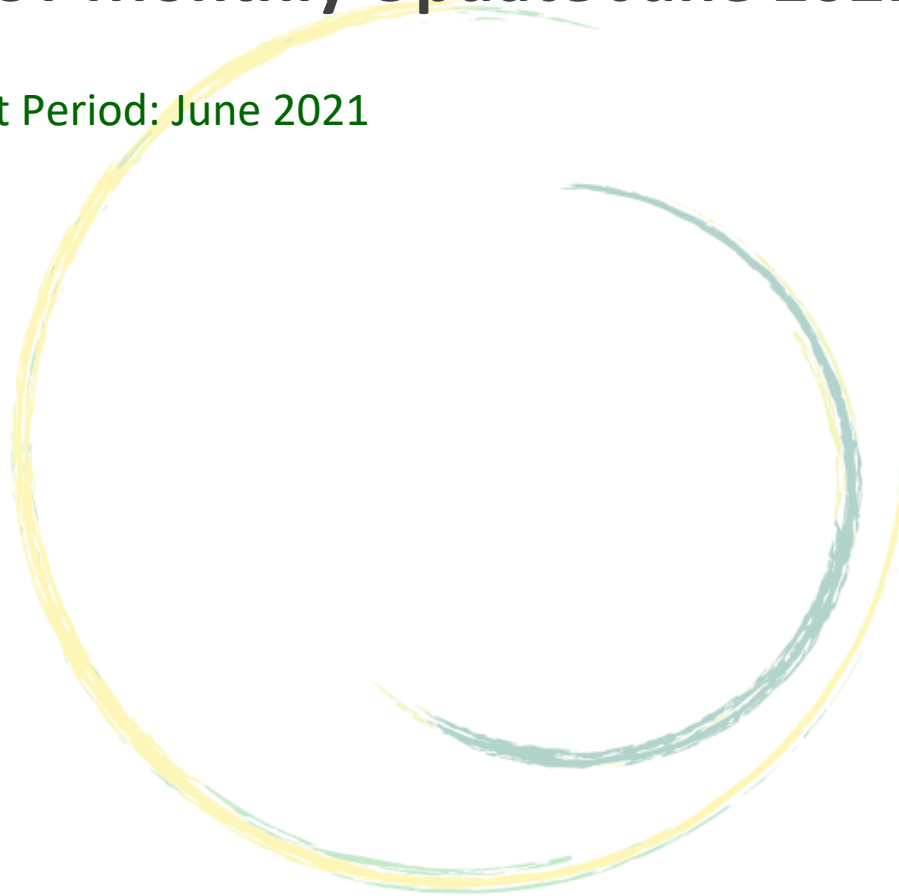

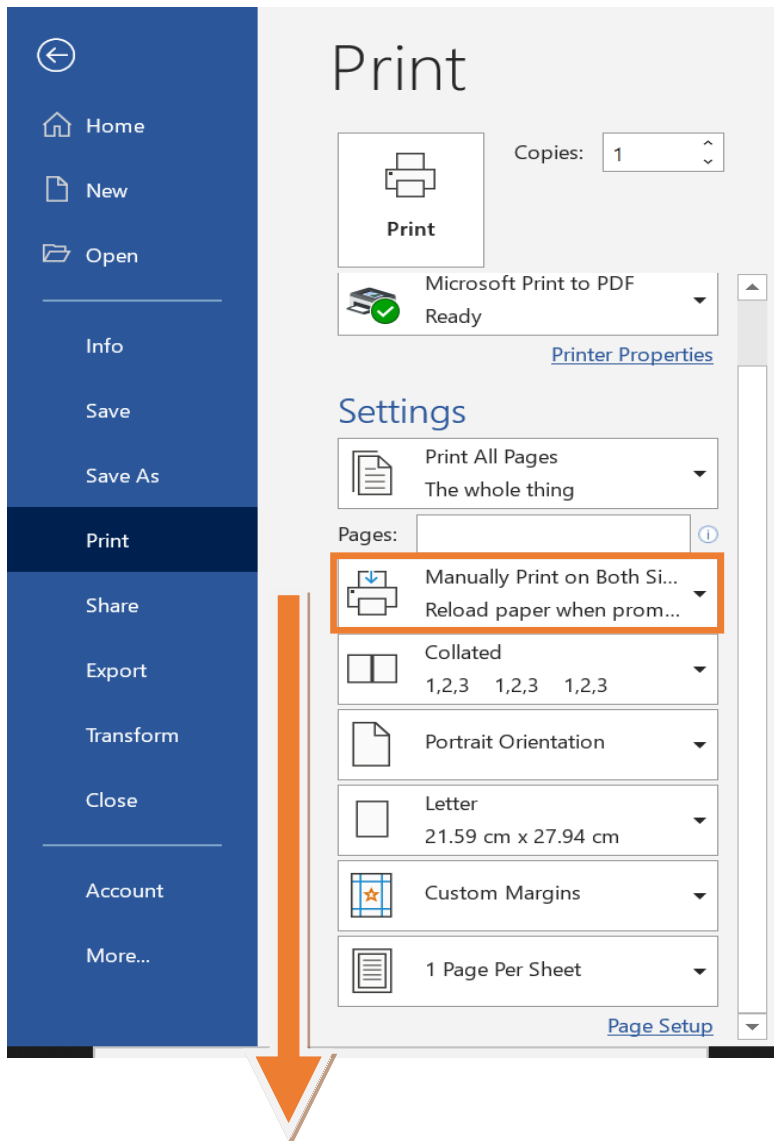

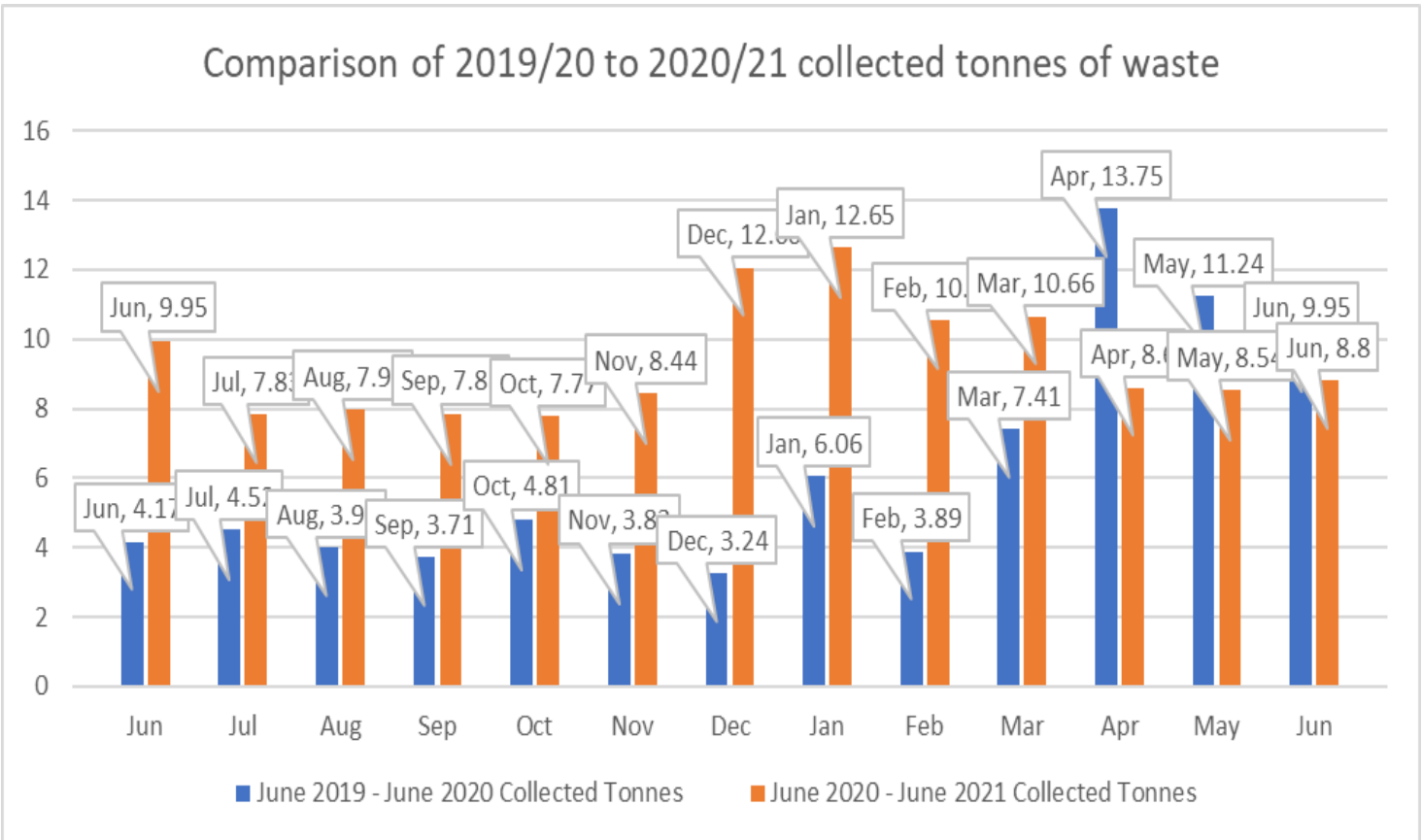

## Clinical Waste

It is clear the impact of COVID-19 has had on the volume of clinical waste being generated through our day-to-day operations. When comparing data between 2019/20 and 2020/21, in every month the Trust has generated more tonnes of clinical waste this year compared to the previous. However, April 2021 goes against this trend having a lower rate of collected tonnes than April 2020.
