New Emergency Preparedness e-Learning Modules have recently been uploaded to Evolve for all staff to access as part of continued professional development. These modules have been designed to raise awareness of several different types of incidents that might be encountered and to act as a refresher on your response to such incidents.

These modules can be found in Clinical CPD Courses under the sub-heading Emergency Preparedness e-Learning. Each module has been designed to provide specific information about each of the incident types and is accompanied by a very straightforward knowledge check after each presentation. Once completed they will be recorded within Evolve as part of your CPD.

At present there are 7 modules available:


